*The following is a summary of topics, outcomes, and action items that were discussed at the Cooperating and Participating Agencies meeting*

January 2019

- **Overview:** This was the first meeting for the Cooperating and Participating Agencies. A summary of the roles and responsibilities for these agencies was discussed and background on the project was provided to the group.
- **Cooperating Agencies include:** U.S. Federal Transit Administration, U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, and U.S. Federal Railroad Administration.
- **Participating Agencies include:** City of Minneapolis, City of Saint Paul, Metropolitan Council, Hennepin County, Ramsey County, Minnesota Indian Affairs Council, Minnesota Pollution Control Agency, Board of Water and Soil Resources, Office of the State Archaeologist, State Historic Preservation Office, Minnesota Department of Natural Resources, Capitol Region Watershed District, Mississippi Watershed Management Organization, Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board, Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board, Minnesota Department of Health, and Minnesota Department of Commerce.
- **Coordination Plan:** The group was presented with an overview of the Coordination Plan document and notified that the public engagement plan will also be distributed once it is complete.
- **Draft Purpose, Goals and Logical Termini:** An overview of these three documents were provided to the group.
- **Next Steps:** Comments were requested for the coordination plan, purpose statement, goals statement, and logical termini memo. The second meeting is anticipated to be held in May 2020 to discuss the purpose and need.
