In 2013, Minnesota State Law was changed to provide a **tax exemption** for the sale or purchase and associated installation charges of equipment and parts necessary for repair and maintenance of aircraft. This includes equipment and parts to upgrade and improve **aircraft** (under FAA Regulations, Parts 91 and 135).

The **purpose** of this change is to encourage the growth of the aviation services industry in the state.

In 2016, MnDOT Aeronautics will report to the Legislature on the **impact** of these tax exemptions on aircraft repairs, maintenance, and improvements. **Your input** will help provide a more complete assessment of the tax exemption impacts on **private businesses** and **aviation** in Minnesota.
