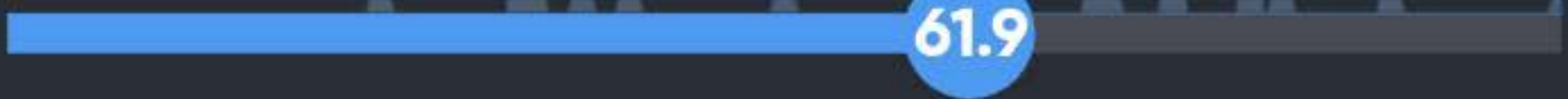

Investing in and building out safe, reliable, efficient pedestrian, bicycle and transit infrastructure statewide

With an equitable, clean, multimodal system. CAV can improve things or exacerbate existing problems

Collaboration, public private partnerships, defined goals, multiple stakeholders

Developing a transportation system that works for all users and makes use of the available space. Uses new technologies to enhance the user experience.

Inclusionary, people and safety focused for all users and mode choices.

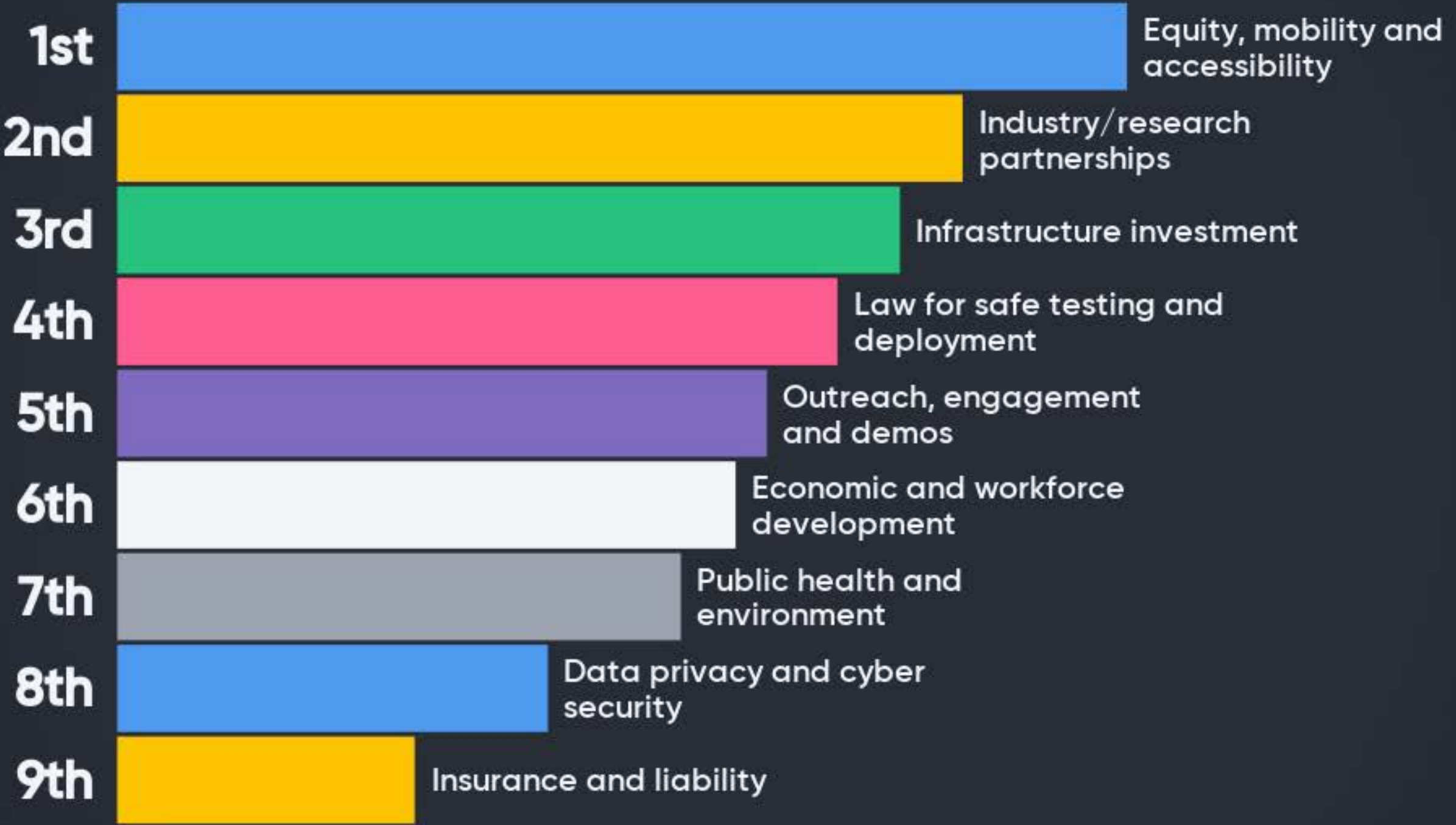


How do we accomplish these goals?

Sustainability and environmental protection.

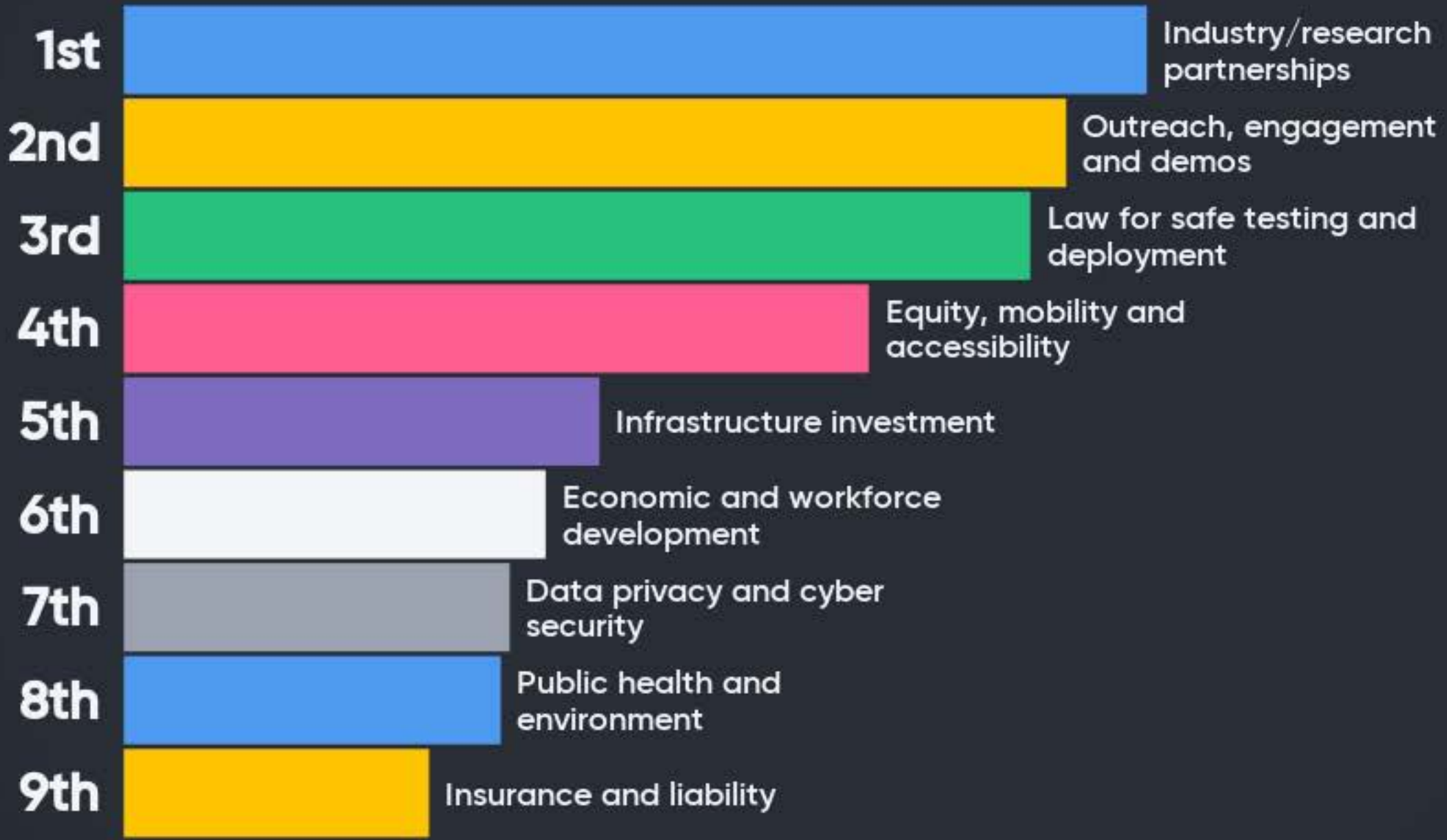
Examine pilots going on in other states and countries
