Minnesota Highway Construction Cost Index 2nd Quarter 2021

Minnesota Highway Construction Cost Index

The Minnesota Highway Construction Cost Index is an indicator of price trends for highway construction. Each quarter, an average unit price is computed for six indicator items. The unit prices are based upon bids from projects let during that quarter. Prices from projects which cost less than \$100,000, and projects which use Design Build, Contract Manager/General Contractor (CMGC), Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Delivery (IDIQ) and Emergency Order Project methods of contracting are not included in the Cost Index. The average unit price and quantity for these six indicator items along with the corresponding 1987 Base Year data is used to compute three sub-indices and the composite index. Each index and the associated indicator items are listed in Table 1.

2nd Quarter 2021 Indices

The Composite Minnesota Highway Construction Cost Index for the 2nd Quarter 2021 was not computed due to the absence of data for the Structural Steel Indicator Item. The other 2nd Quarter 2021 Indices are compared to the 2nd Quarter 2020 Indices in Table 2.

Excavation

The average Excavation cost was \$11.65/CY, up \$1.35/CY from the 2nd Quarter of 2020. Three (3) projects were considered this quarter.

Plant Mixed Bituminous Pavement

The average Plant Mixed Bituminous cost was \$58.98/ton, down \$4.12/ton from the 2nd Quarter of 2020. Fifteen (15) projects were considered this quarter.

Concrete Pavement

The average Concrete Pavement cost was \$168.84/CY. Three (3) projects were considered this quarter.

Structural Concrete

The average Structural Concrete cost was \$1,162.46/CY, up \$0.42/CY from the 2nd Quarter of 2020. One (1) project was considered this quarter.

Reinforcing Steel

The average Reinforcing Steel cost was \$1.94/lb, up \$0.41/lb from the 2nd Quarter of 2020. Two (2) projects were considered this quarter.

Structural Steel

There were no projects with Structural Steel this quarter.
