

- IV. **Poster Boards** – The Prime Contractor shall place a federal-aid poster board, accessible to all workers, on the project site from the first day of work until the project is 100% complete. Posters can be obtained by calling (651) 296-0854.
- V. **Submission of Certified Payroll Reports** – Payroll reports (e.g. WH-347) must be submitted weekly to the Project Engineer, along with the signed *Statement of Compliance Form* (e.g. Mn/DOT 21658).
- VI. **Overtime Requirements** – In accordance with federal DBRA, an employee must be paid, at a minimum, a rate of at least 1 ½ times the contract basic rate plus applicable fringe benefits for all hours worked in excess of 40 hours per week.
- VII. **Employee Interviews** – In order to ensure compliance, personnel from the contracting agency and/or other federal/state agencies will be conducting random monthly interviews. Interviews will be conducted during employee work hours.

## Prevailing Wage – Federal Funded “Only” Contracts Pre-Construction Meeting Agenda

### PREFACE

This contract is funded in whole or in part with federal funds and is subject to the federal Davis-Bacon and Related Acts (DBRA). Therefore, all contractors performing work under this contract shall demonstrate compliance with the contract labor provisions.

- II. **Request To Sublet** – The Prime Contractor shall complete a *Request To Sublet Form* (e.g. TP-21834) when subcontracting any portion of the contract. Please refer to Section 1801, Mn/DOT's *Standard Specifications for Construction; 2005 Edition* for subletting provisions.
- III. **Wage Decisions & Labor Provisions** – The Prime Contractor shall review the contract federal general decision and complete a *Request For Authorization of Additional Classification and Rate Form* (e.g. SF-1444) regarding any labor classification that is missing from the decision. Additionally, the Prime Contractor shall provide copies of all applicable contract labor provisions, including the federal wage decision(s) to each subcontractor that performs work under this contract.
