

- V. **Submission of Certified Payroll Reports** – The time frame regarding the submission of payroll reports, (e.g. WH-347) to the Project Engineer shall be based on the contractor’s employee payment schedule and must include the signed *Statement of Compliance Form* (e.g. Mn/DOT 21658).
- VI. **Overtime Requirements** – In accordance with federal and state law, an employee must be paid a rate of at least 1½ times the hourly basic rate of pay plus applicable fringe benefits for all hours worked in excess of 8 hours per day or 40 hours per week.
- VII. **Submission of Month-End Trucking Reports** – Trucking reports (e.g. TP-90550) are to be submitted monthly to the Project Engineer, along with the signed *Statement of Compliance Form* (e.g. TP-90551).
- VIII. **Employee Interviews** – In order to ensure compliance, personnel from the contracting agency and/or other federal/state agencies will be conducting random monthly interviews. Interviews will be conducted during employee work hours.

PREFACE

- II. **Request To Sublet** – The Prime Contractor shall complete a *Request To Sublet Form* (e.g. TP-21834) when subcontracting any portion of the contract. Please refer to Section 1801, Mn/DOT’s *Standard Specifications for Construction; 2005 Edition* for subletting provisions.
- III. **Wage Decisions & Labor Provisions** – The Prime Contractor shall provide copies of all applicable contract labor provisions and state wage decision(s) to all subcontractors that perform work under this contract.
- IV. **Poster Boards** – The Prime Contractor shall place a state-aid poster board on the project site, accessible to all workers, from the first day of work until the project is 100% complete. Posters can be obtained by calling (651) 296-0854.
