<b>Description:</b>	Topics covered in the course will include principles and setup of temporary traffic controls (both short and long term) and summary of traffic control special provisions for MnDOT projects. The course will make use of actual traffic control plans and contracts. Other subjects covered are work zone speed limits, use of portable concrete barrier and crash testing requirements.
<b>Learning Objectives</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Become acquainted with and understand use of appropriate temporary traffic control reference materials and any changes to reference materials.</li> <li>• Obtain knowledge and reading of MnDOT contracts, plans and specification relating to traffic control.</li> <li>• Gain knowledge of federal requirements contained in the Americans with Disabilities Act Understand requirements and guidelines for the use of Temporary Speed Limits and Portable Concrete Barrier.</li> <li>• Be aware of yearly changes in the MnDOT Traffic Control (2562) Special Provisions and updates on policies and requirements of traffic control devices.</li> <li>• Upon completion of the three-day course and passing a written exam, participants will receive certification and meet the qualifications of the MnDOT Traffic Control Supervisor special provision specification.</li> </ul>
