

## **Class Description:**

This three day training course is designed for Traffic Control Supervisors who will be working in Minnesota on state projects. Topics covered in the course will include principles and setup of temporary traffic controls, summary of traffic control special provisions for Mn/DOT projects and will make use of actual traffic control plans. Other subjects covered are work zone speed limits, use of portable concrete barrier and the NCHRP 350 crash requirements.

## **Questions and Answers:**

- Q. Will my National ATSSA Traffic Control Supervisor Certification still be valid and meet Mn/DOT specification requirements?
- A. Yes, The revised specification will allow Mn/DOT Traffic Control Supervisor Certification or National ATSSA Certification obtained before January 26, 2007.**
- Q. What if my National ATSSA Traffic Control Supervisor Certification has expired?
- A. If your certification has expired you will be required to complete the Mn/DOT Traffic Control Supervisor course in it's entirety along with the written exam in order to gain Mn/DOT certification.**
- Q. What if my National ATSSA Traffic Control Supervisor Certification expires after January 1, 2009?
- A. If your National ATSSA Traffic Control Supervisor Certification expires at any time between January 1, 2009 and January 26, 2011, Mn/DOT Certification can be obtained by showing proof of National ATSSA Traffic Control Supervisor Certification, attending the one-day Mn/DOT Traffic Control Supervisor Recertification class, and passing a short written recertification exam with a score of 70% or higher.**

- Q. Is there a deadline for acceptance of the National ATSSA Traffic Control Supervisor Certification?
- A. National ATSSA Traffic Control Supervisor Certification will no longer be accepted after January 26, 2011.**
- Q. What happens if I don't pass the exam?
- A. If your score is between 60 – 69% you may re-take the exam once without fee. If you do not pass this retake you must repeat the Mn/DOT Traffic Control Supervisor course in full and all fees will be applied.**
- Q. When will I receive my new certification card from Mn/DOT?
- A. Certification cards are sent the month of May. You will receive a new certification card every year.**
- Q. How long will the certification for Mn/DOT Traffic Control Supervisor Certification be valid?
- A. The certification period will be five years.**
- Q. How much will this course cost?
- A. The course and certification will cost \$250.00. The cost for recertification class and exam will be \$125.00.**

- Q. Where will the training for this course be held?
- A. The Mn/DOT Traffic Control Supervisor Certification course will be offered at least once a year at a Twin City location.**
