### **Minnesota Intrastate Passenger Registration Supplemental Instructions For Completion of Motor Carrier Identification Report (MCS-150)**

Return the completed MCS-150 form to the Minnesota Department of Transportation, Office of Freight and Commercial Vehicle Operations.  
(See address at top of page.)

The use of this form for Minnesota Passenger Carrier Registration is required in Minnesota Statute 22.0252 subd. 1. With the completion of this form, all Minnesota intrastate passenger carriers will be issued a US DOT number. For those carriers who already have a US DOT number, the data will be used to update your carrier information.

Complete blocks 1-30 on the MCS-150 form using the instructions attached. Also, use the following supplemental instructions:

| Block 23 | In addition to any other operation classifications that may apply, circle L and list the classification "MN Intrastate Passenger Authorized For-Hire".  |
| Block 26 | In determining the number of limousines; use the Minnesota definition for a limousine. Limousine means an unmarked luxury passenger automobile that is not a van or station wagon and has a seating capacity of not more than 12 persons, excluding the driver. |
| Block 30 | For the purpose of the Intrastate Passenger Registration, this form must be signed by a corporate officer, general partner, limited liability company board member, or sole proprietor.   |
