

## Attachment to: Refuse Compactor Annual Permit

This addendum must be attached to a valid Refuse Compactor Annual Permit.

The MnDOT Oversize/Overweight (OSOW) Permit Office's Internet Home Page is noted above.

1. Travel under this permit is prohibited on Interstate routes.
2. The Refuse Compactor Annual Permit allows multiple axle configurations on a single truck having a self-contained refuse compactor permanently mounted upon its truck frame.
  - a. If a refuse compactor truck has a lift axle(s), maximum axle group and gross vehicle weight will be based on the number of axles that are on the ground, distributing their full share of weight.
3. This permit does not supersede actual bridge and road posted limits.
4. This permit is valid only for a self-contained single vehicle refuse compactor having a total of up to four axles.
5. Maximum permitted axle weights on a "drive axle group" are:
  - a. Up to 22,000 lbs. on a single axle drive
  - b. Up to 38,000 lbs. on a tandem axle drive, with no single axle greater than 19,000 lbs.
  - c. Up to 46,000 lbs. on a 3-axle drive, with no single axle greater than 15,334 lbs.
6. Maximum permitted gross vehicle weights (GVW) are:
  - a. Up to 2,000 lbs. over legal (non-permit) weight GVW for 2-axle vehicle
  - b. Up to 4,000 lbs. over legal (non-permit) weight GVW for 3-axle and 4-axle vehicles
  - c. The GVW of a 4-axle vehicle may not exceed 62,000 lbs. GVW, even if axle spacing would allow more
7. Cannot exceed 600 lbs. per inch width of tire, or manufacturer's rated tire limit, whichever is less.
