



MN Oversize/Overweight Transportation Travel Hours

DAILY, CONTINUOUS:

- Exceptions noted below and/or on permit credential.

EXCEPTIONS:

- ***Twin Cities Rush Hour Zone***
 - Loads exceeding 12'6" wide, 14'0" high, and 95'0" overall combination length (single motor vehicle limit of 60'0") are not allowed to travel M – F, 6:00 – 8:30 AM & 3:30 – 6:00 PM
 - During rush hour period, all over-legal loads prohibited on MN244 between Washington CR12 in Mahtomedi and MN96 in Dellwood
 - Twin Cities boundaries are: *All of Anoka, Hennepin, Ramsey, and Washington Counties; all of Chisago and Isanti counties south of MN95 between Jct US169 in Princeton and Jct US8/MN95 in Taylors Falls; US169 between MN95 in Princeton and Jct US10/US169/MN101 in Elk River; MN101 in Elk River; US10 between SE Jct US10/MN25 in Big Lake and the west limits of Anoka County; all of Carver and Wright Counties east of MN25; all in Dakota, Goodhue, Rice, and Scott Counties north of MN19, except US61 between MN19 and MN316.*
- ***Duluth Rush Hour Zone***
 - Loads exceeding 12'6" wide, 14' 0" high, and 95'0" long (single motor vehicle at 60'0") are not allowed to travel M – F, 7:00 – 8:30 AM & 4:00 – 5:30 PM
 - Duluth boundaries are: *US2 between Jct US2 Midway Rd (St Louis CR13) and the MN/WI border; I35 between Jct US2 Midway Rd (St Louis CR13) and its northern terminus at Jct MN61; US53 between the MN/WI border and the terminus of I535 just N of Jct I35/I535; I535 between the MN/WI border and its northern termini at Jct I535/I35/US53.*

- **Summer Weekends, no travel**
 - From Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend, NO travel after 2PM on Fridays and Sundays

- **Holidays**
 - New Years Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day
 - If Holiday falls on Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday.
 - No travel from 2PM the day before until 2AM the day after the holiday
 - If Holiday falls on Friday or Saturday
 - No travel from 2PM Thursday until 2AM Monday after the holiday
 - If Holiday falls on a Sunday or Monday
 - No travel from 2PM Friday until 2AM Tuesday after the holiday
 - Travel allowed between 2AM & 5AM on morning of the holiday and holiday weekend days

- **Walleye & Northern Pike Statewide Fishing Opener**
 - No travel from 2PM Friday until 2AM Monday

- **Local Events** (i.e. Minnesota State Fair)
 - Restrictions will be noted on permit credential
 - Unless otherwise noted, travel allowed between 2AM & 5AM on morning of the local event

*** Travel restrictions may be waived for emergency situations that involve the safety and welfare of a large segment of the population (i.e. a train derailment blocking a highway or rail line).

Any exceptions to permit travel hours listed in the paragraphs above must be noted on the OS/OW Transportation Permit. ***
