



# Weekly Construction Update S.P. 6910-96 Grand Avenue 2 Reconstruction

**DATE: October 13, 2016**

A lane closure has been setup at the Kingsbury Creek Bridge and will be in place for about a week. Concrete pavement was found to not meet specifications and required removal and replacement.

Work that is taking place this week will include:

- Bituminous pavement on all northbound lanes
- Utility installation will continue in the southbound lanes
- Concrete curb will be installed in the southbound lanes
- Shoulders will be installed south of 88<sup>th</sup> ave
- Pavement pour under the Munger Trail Bridge
- Utility relocation is occurring near 88<sup>th</sup> ave west
- Signal installation at 88<sup>th</sup> ave west
- Removal of sheet pile at the Knowlton Creek location
- Replacement of pavement at culvert locations

**Traffic changes expected this week:**

**A lane closure has been placed at the Kingsbury Creek Bridge**

Traffic will be switched into the northbound lanes from Becks Road to 83<sup>rd</sup> Ave west. And onto the new bridge.
