

CN Oliver Bridge Rehabilitation Project Update – November 3, 2017

The continuation of work to the CN Oliver Bridge rail deck is proceeding as scheduled. 91% of the bridge rail deck has been replaced to date. New timber panel material for the remaining 9% of the bridge rail deck has been received on-site, been processed into panels, and is staged for installation during rail traffic outages. Span 1 on the Wisconsin side of the bridge was replaced successfully on Wednesday, August 30th.

Road closures to the Oliver Bridge will continue daily on Monday-Friday from 8AM to 5PM. At this time, it is anticipated that daily road closures will continue through November 17th, but is subject to change based on deck installation productivity.
