


Reconstruct Highway 55 Buffalo to Rockford

Between Division St in Buffalo and the Crow River bridge in Rockford in Wright County

Summary of 2018 work

- Reconstruct between Division Street in Buffalo and Autumn Oaks/Electric Drive in Rockford; road will be closed to through traffic July-August, follow signed detour through Delano
- Resurface between Autumn Oaks/Electric
 Drive and the Crow River bridge in Rockford
- Replace or repair underground culverts and cattle pass structures
- Upgrade guardrail
- Install new center left-turn lane at Highway 55/Walnut Place
- Upgrade signal at Highway 55/Main Street
- Upgrade pedestrian sidewalks in Rockford
- Maintain access to businesses and residences throughout project

Schedule and traffic plans

Dates	Impacts
Mid-June to early-July	Intermittent lane and shoulder closures, flaggers, crews and heavy equipment along detour route and on segments of Highway 55
July 5 to early-August	In Rockford – Lane closures, flaggers on Highway 55 between Autumn Oaks/Electric Drive and the Crow River bridge West Rockford to Buffalo – Highway 55 between Division Street in Buffalo and Autumn Oaks/Electric Drive in Rockford closes to through traffic. A signed detour will take you through Delano (see below map).
Early-August to mid-Sept.	Periodic lane and shoulder closures, flaggers, crews and heavy equipment along detour route and on segments of Highway 55. Sidewalk closures in Rockford.

Detour uses Hwy 25, Hwy 12, Wright CR 139/County Line Rd, Hennepin CR 11 and Hennepin CR 92/Dogwood St.

Buffalo to Rockford is Open
