


## Future projects in Brainerd/Baxter area

Planned State highway and bridge projects in the Brainerd/Baxter area through 2026:

- Reconstruct the Hwy 210 road surface, replace/repair pipes and improve access from the end
  of the four-lane in Brainerd to Ironton in 2019. The work will require a detour. Learn more,

- Reconstruct Business Hwy 371 from Greenwood St/Crow Wing CR 23 to Joseph St in Brainerd in 2022. Project includes pedestrian sidewalks and signal upgrades at Industrial Park Rd/Buffalo Hills Ln.
- Resurface Business Hwy 371 from Greenwood St/Crow Wing CR 23 to north of the Hwy 371/Business Hwy 371 interchange in Brainerd in 2022. Project includes left turn lanes at Greenwood St., St. Mathias Rd and 70<sup>th</sup> Ave.
- Replace the Hwy 25 bridge over the BNSF railroad tracks, north of Hwy 18/Oak St in Brainerd in 2022.
- Install Reduced Conflict Intersections (RCIs) on Hwy 371 to improve access and motorist safety at CR 125/Gull Lake Dam Rd and CR 126/Green Gables Rd in Brainerd in 2022.
- Resurface both directions of Hwy 210 from Baxter Dr to the end of the four-lane, west of Meredith Drive, in Baxter in 2023.



 Reconstruct and improve both directions of Hwy 210/Washington St from Baxter Dr to the east end of the four-lane in Brainerd, includes pedestrian sidewalks and intersection improvements in 2025-2026. A corridor study will be conducted in the upcoming years.
