

Overview

In early July, a \$7.2 million Highway 65 resurfacing improvement project will begin from the northern city limits of Mora at Mora Lake to Highway 27 in Woodland (17 miles).

Work on this project will require road closures and a planned two stage detour. Weather permitting, all work is to be completed by the mid September.



What's Stabilized Reclamation

This road surfacing project is using a construction process called Stabilized Reclamation.

Crews will grind and mix the current pavement surface with the gravel and add a stabilizing agent to strengthen the recycled (reclaimed) pavement materials. A new, thin layer of black top will then be paved over the reclaimed surface.

Reclamation saves money by reusing the roadway materials versus milling off the old pavement surface and replacing it with a brand new, thicker layer of bituminous.



Planned Detour

Stage I

July - August

Highway 65 will be closed to through traffic from Woodland to just north of Mora. Detour via Kanabec County Road 6/East Maple Avenue in Mora to Highway 47 and Highway 27. Motorists may encounter parking restrictions in Mora.

Stage II

September

Highway 65 will be closed to through traffic from Woodland to Kanabec County Road 3. Detour via Kanabec County Highway 3, Highway 47 and Highway 27.

Truck Route

Semi trailer drivers traveling through the area are asked to utilize Highway 23, Highway 47 and Highway 27 for the duration of the project.
