



# Highway 52 Safety, Access and Interchange Location Study

May 15, 2012

Over the past several months, the Minnesota Department of Transportation, Goodhue County and Leon, Stanton, and Cannon Falls Township officials have partnered to study options for addressing safety and access concerns along Highway 52 between Hader and the southern limits of Cannon Falls.

As part of this study, the location of a future interchange in the vicinity of Goodhue County Road 1 or Goodhue County Road 9 is being evaluated. The long-range plan for Highway 52 is to develop a freeway corridor between Rochester and St. Paul, which would mean controlled access onto the highway by interchanges only.


Options for closing access to Highway 52 at Goodhue County Road 14 and the rerouting of Goodhue County Road 14 are also being considered as part of this study. An extension of Goodhue County Road 14 to Cannon Falls would provide an opportunity to further improve safety and enhance local roadway connections by minimizing at-grade access to Highway 52.
