



Scheduling Considerations




Schedule Considerations

- 2-year Construction Schedule
- Schedule based on Probable "Working Days"
 - May through October
- Task Completion based on Plan Quantities and Reasonable Production Rates for:
 - Removals
 - Utilities Sanitary Sewer, Watermain, Storm Sewer
 - Grading and Base
 - Concrete Roadway Pavement









2-Year Construction Schedule

- 214 Days of Work
- 1st Year: May 2016 October 2016
- 2nd Year: May 2017 September 2017
- More Flexibility to Accommodate Unexpected Issues/Delays
- More Options for Local Circulation
- Hwy 60 to Downtown Business District Open After 1st Year










Intersection Construction with Traffic

11th Street at 7th Avenue




11th Street at 10th Avenue


















- 20% of Hwy 4 traffic likely to use entire detour
 - Up to 300 vehicles per day
 - Up to 60 trucks per day
 - One truck every 7-10 minutes during busiest hour
- Detour route expected to increase traffic on:
 - 10th Avenue S by 15%
 - 1st Avenue S by less than 5%




Business Access Signage Chamber Example
