Be Safe in Work Zones

- Be aware of road work in your area or along your daily commute.
- Expect the unexpected! Road surfaces and traffic patterns change frequently in work zones.
- Stay alert and give your full attention to the roadway.
- Slow down and watch for workers, heavy/slow moving equipment and pavement markings or uneven pavement.
- Don't tailgate! Keep a safe distance between you and the vehicle in front of you – sudden stops are common in construction zones.
- Be patient. Remember work zones are necessary to improve roads and make them safer.

Project Details

In early July, work begins on reconstructing Highway 12 near the Highway 71 Bypass in Willmar. The \$3 million dollar Highway 12 reconstruction project is a one mile, two-stage project that spans the Highway 71 Bypass Bridge in Willmar.

The eastern portion of the project ends a half mile east of the Highway 71 Bypass Bridge. This portion requires a detour to allow crews to remove and replace an entire section of pavement.

The western edge of the project ends one half mile west of the Highway 71 Bypass Bridge.

In addition, crews will be constructing a right turn lane at 7th Street and making American Disability Act (ADA) improvements from 6th Street to Lakeland Drive.

Access will be maintained to local businesses and Kandiyohi County Road 9 will remain open to traffic for the duration of the project.

Work is expected to be completed in November 2014, weather permitting.

Construction

Our goal is to reconstruct the Highway 12 project as quickly, and safely, as possible.

During construction there may be inconveniences to your mobility. Representatives from MnDOT and the prime contractor will work with you to minimize those impacts.
