## Area residents invited to open house on recommended safety strategies for Highway 23 through Marshall

WILLMAR, Minn. – Area residents, business owners and others are invited to attend an open house on Tuesday, June 21 from 4-6 pm in Marshall.

The Minnesota Department of Transportation and its partners, the city of Marshall, Lyon County and the Marshall Chamber of Commerce are conducting a safety assessment to evaluate the current and future performance of Highway 23 and develop short and long term strategies to manage the corridor now and in the future.

The open house will be held from 4 to 6 pm at the Marshall-Lyon County Library (201 C St. in Marshall) in the Community Room. There will be a formal presentation at 4:30 pm on recommended strategies to increase safety on Highway 23 through Marshall. Participants will be asked to rank, in priority order, intersections along Highway 23 as well as potential safety improvements.

Community members are encouraged to come anytime between 4 and 6 p.m. as there will be time before and after the presentation to view and rank strategies as well as speak with staff from SRF Consulting Group and other assessment partners (City of Marshall, Marshall Area Transportation Group, Lyon County and MnDOT District 8).

Information gained from the community will be used as part of the safety assessment report which will be presented to the public in August of 2016.
