

Highway 75 Project - Pipestone

Project summary

The Minnesota Department of Transportation will be resurfacing Highway 75 from the junction of Highway 23/Highway 30 to the junction of Highway 23/Highway 75 in Pipestone. The project area is a little more than 1/2 mile in length. In addition to the resurfacing of the road, MnDOT will be constructing a continuous two-way left turn lane and updating pedestrian facilities to meet the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards.

This project will **NOT require detour**. The project will go out for bid in January of 2018. Construction is expected to begin summer 2018. Information can be found at www.dot.state.mn.us/d8/projects/hwy75pipestone/index.html.

Project location/cost/timeline

- Highway 75 in Pipestone from the Jct of Hwy 23/Hwy 30 to the Jct of Hwy 23/Hwy 75
- \$1.1 million
- 2018 construction season

Continuous two-way left turn lane

- Will require the **permanent** removal of on-street parking along the project area

ADA improvements

- Update pedestrian facilities along the project area to meet modern ADA standards
