2-1	RFQ 2.8	<p>The following question was asked for a separate Mn/DOT DB Project, but is included to also clarify conflicts of interest for this project:</p> <p>Can sub-consultants to the Mn/DOT Alternative Contracting General Engineering Consultant (GEC) join a design-build team?</p>	<p>Mn/DOT has posted it's design-build conflict of interest approach on the following website: http://www.dot.state.mn.us/designbuild/ An excerpt from the approach states: <i>Consultants will NOT be allowed to participate as an offeror or to join a design-build team if: The Consultant is Mn/DOT's General Engineering Consultant (GEC) to the design-build program.</i> <i>Subconsultants to the GEC that do not perform work on the design build project may participate as an offeror or join a design-build team.</i></p> <p>An excerpt from the GEC RFP stated: <i>Selected GEC subconsultants may be allowed to participate as an offeror or join a design-build team if they did not perform any work for Mn/DOT or other key stakeholders in the preparation of the contract. If a subconsultant chooses to participate as an offeror or join a design-build team, they will not be allowed to perform any oversight work for Mn/DOT on the contract.</i></p> <p>An excerpt from Article 9 of the GEC contract states: <i>Contractor's sub contractors may be allowed to participate as an offeror or join a design-build team if they did not perform any work for the State or other key stakeholders in the preparation of the contract. If a sub contractor chooses to participate as an offeror or join a design-build team, they will not be allowed to perform any</i></p>

2-2	General	When are the electrical plans going to be available for us so we can put a price in for the lighting portion of the project?	Electrical plans will not be available from Mn/DOT. Design-build teams will submit Statement of Qualifications for Mn/DOT's review. Mn/DOT will shortlist the most-highly qualified teams that submit Statement of Qualifications. The short-listed teams will be announced on March 19, 2009. The short-listed teams will submit a technical and price proposal for the project. The single point of contacts for the short-listed teams will be posted to Mn/DOT's website (http://www.dot.state.mn.us/designbuild/stimulus.html). When posted, you may contact these teams regarding subcontracting opportunities and project requirements.
2-3	General	We are looking at the lighting that will be done on this project in St Peter. Question I have is the lighting levels that need to have on 169 thru St Peter. Would you be able to give us the levels that are needed there?	Technical requirements for the lighting on TH169 will be included in the Request for Proposal when it is released on March 27, 2009.
