8-1	Book 1	Please clarify which portions of the Contracting entity are required to have Professional Liability insurance.	Only those members of the Design-Build team that will be performing professional services are required to have Professional Liability insurance.
8-2		What is the policy regarding price changes between October 15 (proposal due date) and November 19 (price proposal opening)?	The Proposal Price submitted on October 15, 2004 shall be the Proposer's price for the Project. This Proposal Price will be used for determining the Best Value and will become the Contract amount.
8-3	ITP	Please clarify the appropriate use of Form 20 – Guaranty.	As stated in the ITP Section 4.3.3.2 A Guaranty is required if (a) Proposer's organization is a newly formed corporation or other limited liability entity or (b) the form of organization of Proposer and/or the financially responsible parties comprising Proposer changes and Mn/DOT determines, in its sole discretion, to require a Guarantor as a condition to approving such change under Section 1.5. Proposers that do not meet a) or b) in the above paragraph do not need to complete Form 20 – Guaranty.
8-4	Book 1	When will Mn/DOT provide wage rates in the Appendix F of Book 1.	The wage rates will be provided in the final addendum. The source of wage rates and how they apply to the project are the same as for traditional projects.
