RE: Report on Special Revenue Fund Agreements for FY 2013

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes Section 174.02, the Minnesota Department of Transportation is submitting the attached report on Special Revenue Fund Agreements. The legislation allows MnDOT to engage in partnership projects that increase the effectiveness of government and further the goal of increased government cooperation through agreements with other governmental and nongovernmental entities for research and experimentation; for sharing facilities, equipment, staff, data, or other means of providing transportation-related services; or for other cooperative programs that promote efficiency in providing governmental services or that further innovation in transportation.

In FY 2013, MnDOT entered into 24 partnership agreements with receipts exceeding \$100,000. Information on each of these agreements is provided in the attached report.
