RE: Report on the Transportation Economic Development (TED) Program

Dear Legislators:

We are pleased to provide the report on the Transportation Economic Development Program, more commonly referred to as TED. This report is required under Minnesota Statutes 2013, 174.12, subdivision 8.

The program is a collaborative effort between the Minnesota Department of Transportation and the Minnesota Department of Economic Development to provide funding for projects to enhance the transportation system and improve economic growth.

The 30 projects in the TED program were developed by local governments and were designed to leverage other public and private investment. Over the three years, the TED program has leveraged more than \$122 million in outside investments in the 30 projects and will support more than 15,000 jobs around those projects.
