I am pleased to present MnDOT's annual transit report. This report includes all information on transit service in Greater Minnesota required by Minn. Stat. 174.247. In addition, it provides a comprehensive overview of the state's public transit services by highlighting accomplishments; listing ridership, financial and performance information; and providing a snapshot of every public transit provider in the state.

Transit is a key component of Minnesota's multimodal transportation system, contributing to the health of people, the environment and the economy. In Minnesota, 61 public transit systems in 86 counties offer scheduled transportation service to the public.
