RE: 2015 Nonemergency Medical Transportation report

Dear Legislators:

I am pleased to provide the report on Nonemergency Medical Transportation (NEMT). This report is required under 2014 Laws of Minnesota, Chapter 312, Article 24, Section 45 Subdivision 4.

The report is a follow-up to the 2014 proposal from the Nonemergency Medical Transportation Advisory Committee to subject nonemergency medical transportation providers to MnDOT's rules and operating standards for special transportation services. This report lays out the necessary statutory, rulemaking and any other authority needed to implement the program within MnDOT. The Law also required that a fee be estimated to cover the costs of sustaining the program, including the cost of the supervision of the inspection and certification of nonemergency medical transportation vehicles and providers.
