Description of project

The objective of this project is to provide guidance and assistance to MnDOT Districts statewide scoping and project development processes to fulfill the implementation requirements of 23 CFR 940 for all ITS projects or projects with an ITS component. This project includes: performing an educational outreach effort to MnDOT Districts to understand the purpose of the FHWA Implementation Memo, modifying and incorporating ITS and Systems Engineering concept into project scoping documents and worksheets, developing a procedure for the implementation of ITS projects, and provide training to MnDOT staff on the procedure for ITS implementation.

Benefits

The project will provide the following benefits:

- Ensure compliance with federal requirements and eligibility for federal funds
- Enhance financial effectiveness
- Foster integration of ITS deployment
- Promote proper consideration of interoperability and future expansion
