Rubberized Asphalt Melter Applicator

The Kera-10 Melter Applicator reduced labor costs by 50% over the silicone tube method of sealing and filling bridge joints. The District 1A Duluth Bridge Crew intends to use it whenever possible. Rubberized asphalt costs around \$3.00 per gallon compared to \$104.00 per gallon for silicone. This unit is much safer than using a melting pot and hand held torch because employees do not come into contact with the burner and pot.
