### M.O.R. Test Bed Tandem

Working in conjunction with Central Shop's Randy Cameron, M.O.R. will be testing and evaluating new items such as, a radius truck box, high speed plow, pour in box liner, hydraulic controls, transmission mounted hydraulic pump, and pre-wetting saddle tanks. An important part of this project is the assistance of Mn/DOT maintenance personnel in using these test items under actual working conditions. The Test Bed Tandem project has started at Metro Division's Maryland Avenue Truck Station and will be moved periodically to other areas.
