Bituminous Thermal Crack Repair

District 7E Mankato is evaluating several methods and materials for bituminous crack repair. A one mile section of T.H. 60 has been designated as the test section. Two premium materials and methods are being compared to the current “throw and go” and “maintenance skid steer full width patching” methods. Deery Level-N-Go and Crafcro PolyPatch are the choices for this premium material evaluation and will be monitored for ride quality, longevity, and cost effectiveness.
