Cart-Away Concrete trailer with loading system

Rotating drum trailers replicate what happens at a typical ready mix operation and they have all the advantages associated with ready mix. Chemicals and fiber can also be added to the mix. The concrete is completely mixed and requires no remixing at the jobsite. With this concrete trailer, District 6 bridge and maintenance crews will mix concrete on the job site and mix whatever quantity needed to complete the repairs. This piece of equipment is used for bridge concrete deck repairs, bridge concrete railing repairs, maintenance concrete curbing repairs, and maintenance water concrete inlet repairs. It will replace the need to call a concrete truck and eliminate the 3 cubic yard small order charge.
