HI VIZ Chainsaw Chaps

Tree cutting is often done during low light and dark times after strong storms pass through and leave down trees lying across roadways. Currently, flagging pants are worn <u>over</u> protective chainsaw chaps to give the much needed visibility. This can create a safety hazard because flagging pants are generally very loose fitting. These HI VIZ Chainsaw Chaps are great for chainsaw work in areas where visibility is a must. The chaps have 2" wide reflective stripes; a side pocket and have are water and oil resistant. District 1 will evaluate these chaps for their durability, effectiveness in low light, and whether or not the retro reflectivity creates a safer work environment for the workers wearing them and those working around them.
