

Mn/DOT Approved Certificate of Compliance Programs

The Minnesota Department of Transportation has reviewed a sample of the Certificate of Compliance generated by the following software programs. Based on the submitted samples, these Certificates of Compliance are capable of complying with Mn/DOT Specification 2461.4D7a, dated September 7, 2001.

It is the manufacturer's responsibility to ensure the program is properly installed and immediately notify Mn/DOT if the program is changed or modified, or if the program is no longer being produced. If it is determined that the Certificate of Compliance has changed, without prior notification from the manufacturer, the program may be removed from the Approved Programs list.
