Description:	This one-day course will cover responsibilities related to administering "(2016) Quality Management – Paver Mounted Thermal Profile (PMTP) Method" and "(2016) Quality Management Special – Intelligent Compaction (IC) Method". Topics covered: background information on both the PMTP and IC technologies; lot and sublot establishments; standardized naming of lots; monetary price adjustments; hands-on computer training on how to <u>review Veta projects and forms submitted by the</u> <u>contractors</u> ; and examples of how to identify workmanship issues, in Veta, using measurements from these technologies.
Learning Objectives	When completed the participants will better understand the responsibilities related to administration of the intelligent compaction and paver mounted thermal profiling technologies and how to identify workmanship issues.
Audience:	This course is intended for County, City and State personnel that will be reviewing Veta projects and forms submitted by the Contractors and/or personnel reviewing the submittals for identification of workmanship issues. Personnel interested in better understanding how Veta projects are created from start to finish are encouraged to attend the general Veta training class being offered to Contractors / Consultants in lieu of this class.
