SUBJECT: Finding of No Significant Impact for the I-35W North Corridor Preliminary Design Project (S.P. 6284-172)

On behalf of the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) Metro District, SRF Consulting Group, Inc. is transmitting this memorandum regarding the Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the I-35W North Corridor Preliminary Design Project (S.P. 6284-172). The project proposes pavement rehabilitation on Interstate 35W (I-35W) from County Road C in Roseville to Sunset Avenue in Blaine/Lino Lakes; construction of MnPASS lanes from County Road C to Lexington Avenue in Blaine; construction of auxiliary lanes on I-35W through the Interstate 694 (I-694) interchange area; construction of auxiliary lanes in the I-35W/Trunk Highway (TH) 10 commons area; and construction of a westbound auxiliary lane on TH 10 from I-35W to 93rd Lane. Other project features include construction of stormwater basins and noise walls.

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) has concluded that the project will not cause significant environmental impacts and issued a FONSI for the project on January 25, 2018. MnDOT does not intend to circulate paper copies of the FONSI document and FHWA transmittal letter. 
