

## New Fifth Street SE pedestrian and bicycle bridge

### Minneapolis

The Minnesota Department of Transportation is working on a project to replace the Fifth Street SE pedestrian and bicycle bridge over I-35W in southeast Minneapolis. The project is planned for the spring of 2019.

### Purpose



- Provide safe crossing of I-35W for residents in the Marcy Holmes neighborhood
- Build a new, longer-lasting and safer pedestrian and bicycle bridge
- ADA improvements for better pedestrian accessibility
- Improved approaches to the pedestrian bridge

### Construction schedule

- Construction begins in early 2019

### Traffic impacts

- Two weekend full closures of I-35W, including one for demolition of existing pedestrian bridge
- Weekday overnight full closure of I-35W for beam replacement
- Lane closures on I-35W to construct new pier in median
