Work Description

Support scoping process and development of 10-year plan to identify and document statewide assets related to statewide truck size and weight compliance/enforcement. The plan will address necessary education and public outreach efforts, will collaborate with FHWA on federal requirements, and will define future enforcement strategies, including the use of fixed and mobile enforcement sites, and development of ITS technologies:
