MAJOR PROJECT RESPONSIBILITIES

- State DOT Responsibilities
 - Project Management Plans
 - Initial Financial Plans and Annual Updates
 - Independent Cost Validations
- FHWA Responsibilities
 - Review and approve PMP and Annual FP
 - Independently verify costs
 - Monthly Report on Status

Project Management Plan (PMP) Requirements

- Major Projects require PMP in accordance with FHWA Interim Major Project Guidance
- PMP is prepared by the State and approved by FHWA
- PMP is a "Roadmap" to manage:
 - Scope, Costs, Schedules, Quality, and Federal Requirements
- PMP documents roles and responsibilities of all participating parties

- Prior to initiating NEPA:
 Initial PMP
- Prior to ROD or FONSI:
 First updated PMP
- Prior to initial R/W Authorization:
 Further updated PMP
- Prior to initial Construction Authorization:
 Further updated PMP
- During Construction:Updated PMP as necessary
