Dear Laura Clark:

The provisional approval of Geveko Markings Inc.'s OPTAMARK Preformed Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Material has been extended and is valid until December 31, 2020. This extension allows more time for the installation and evaluation of this product. If the performance is acceptable, this product will be eligible for inclusion on MnDOT's Qualified Products List for pavement markings in the Preformed Thermoplastic Pavement Marking Material category. This provisional approval extension only allows the product to be placed on 2 additional MnDOT construction projects.

In order to use this product on a MnDOT construction project, the following conditions must be met:

1. All requirements of the [Pavement Marking Qualification and Acceptance Program](#) are satisfied.
2. Samples of each product must be sent to the MnDOT Materials lab at:

3. Project Engineer approves of the substitution of material on each project.
4. The material will be applied as detailed in the specifications and special provisions with no additional cost to MnDOT.
5. At least 5 working days prior to installation, the vendor and/or contractor will notify the [Pavement Marking Engineer](#) (please use the provided link as starting point for the email) of the installation date. During installation, the vendor and/or contractor will complete the [Pavement Marking Computerized Data Logging System Excel Template](#). Within 5 working days of installation, the data collected in the Excel template will be submitted to PMdata.dot@state.mn.us. **This information is critical in tracking the performance of the product for evaluation.**
6. The manufacturer and contractor will be responsible for all performance requirements of the pavement marking specifications included in the project contract.
