During our five day study at Moorhead, 550 vehicles stopped. Of this, 431 continued on I-94 to their destination which was Easterly of our areas at Lake Iverson and Lake Iatoka. Of the original 441 vehicles that left Moorhead, 49 or 12% stopped at Lake Iverson and 83 or 20% stopped at Lake Latoka. There were 21 vehicles or 5% that stopped at both Iverson and Latoka.
