Attached are the usage studies of subject rest areas. The percentage of vehicles pulling trailers continues to be about the same. The opening of Burgen Lake has decreased the mainline traffic stopping at Hansel Lake from 15 to about 11.2 percent. This is badly needed, at peak hours Hansel Lake was receiving more traffic than it had room for. Burgen Lake is now receiving heavy usage. However, we would hope this would be alleviated when we get the other westbound sites open.
