SUBJECT: Albert Lea Travel Information Center Usage Study 1-35

Attached is our report covering the subject. The study was conducted for five 8 hour days in August. On these five days during the hours of the survey the rest area was used by about 3,589 people. Travel information was supplied to about 1,208.

Usage of the site and the various facilities was about as anticipated with a couple of exceptions. The percentage of vehicles using the travel information was somewhat lower than anticipated (36 vs 45+). This may be accounted for by the high percentage of people vacationing in Minnesota who were repeats - 69%. These people probably already had a good idea as to where they were going. Also, the percent of vehicles with pets - 9.4% was somewhat less than what we might normally expect about 14%.

One other phenomenon which we have observed during the rest area usage studies since the start of the gas shortage, which completely defies explanation, is the decrease of the average number of persons per vehicle. In this study 2.8. This is down from our earlier studies where we were observing about 3.2 to 3.3%. Why this should be happening, we do not know.
