SUBJECT: Garrison Rest Area Usage Study T.H. 169

This rest area usage study was done to obtain information to be used in spacing future rest areas and providing the proper numbers of facilities necessary at each location.

This information is obtained by giving each car that enters the rest area a list of questions that they fill out during there stay in the area. This list is then collected as the car leaves the area. The Garrison count was done for 8 hrs. a day for 5 days, Thursday - Monday.

The number and type of vehicles passing the area were also counted. This allowed us to develop averages for stopping and length of stay for each type of vehicles using the rest area.
