

2015 Local Road Improvement Program

State Funding

During the 2015 regular session, the legislature appropriated \$8.9 million for the Local Road Improvement Fund under [Minnesota Statutes 174.52](#). The appropriation was provided from General Obligation Bonds (Chapter 5 – HF No. 2).

Local Road Improvement Program projects selected below were either identified through specific session law language or selected through an open solicitation process administered by the MnDOT State Aid for Local Transportation. On August 27 2015, the LRIP Advisory Committee approved seven projects statewide that will improve the safety on the township, city and county local roads.
