

2017 Summary of LRIP Solicitation

The program is funded out of the 2017 General Obligation Bonds:

- \$115,932,000
 - \$90,566,000 specified for 11 projects by legislation
 - \$25,366,000 for the statewide solicitation

Project Selection

The State Aid Division has reviewed applications from the 2017 Local Road Improvement Program (LRIP) solicitation and selected projects with guidance from the LRIP Advisory Committee. The LRIP Advisory Committee set the funding targets as follows:

- 30 percent state aid cities
- 35 percent counties
- 30 percent small cities & townships
- 5 percent discretionary

The selection criteria considered: geographical distribution, eligibility, safety, regional significance, local agency support, availability of other funding sources, useful life, impact, and construction readiness.
