Bridge design competition for grades 7-12

The National Bridge and Structure Competition is held annual for students in grades 7-12 from participating TRAC (Transportation and Civil Engineering) & RIDES (Roadways In Developing Elementary Students) states. Minnesota is a participating state.

TRAC & RIDES is an educational outreach program from the American Association of State Highway Transportation Officials (AASHTO). http://trac.transportation.org

Competition basics

There are 3 divisions: Grades 7-8, Grades 9-10, and Grades 11-12.

Students form teams of up to 3 students. Each team must have an adult advisor. Up to 5 teams allowed per school.

Teams submit an application of interest to the competition. Teams receive a bridge design kit, which has the materials for the competition.

Teams complete and design and proposal package and send it in to be judged.

The top 3 teams in each division are invited to the AASHTO spring meeting to compete against each other. The trip is paid for by the competition. Teams can win cash prizes for their school!
