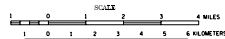

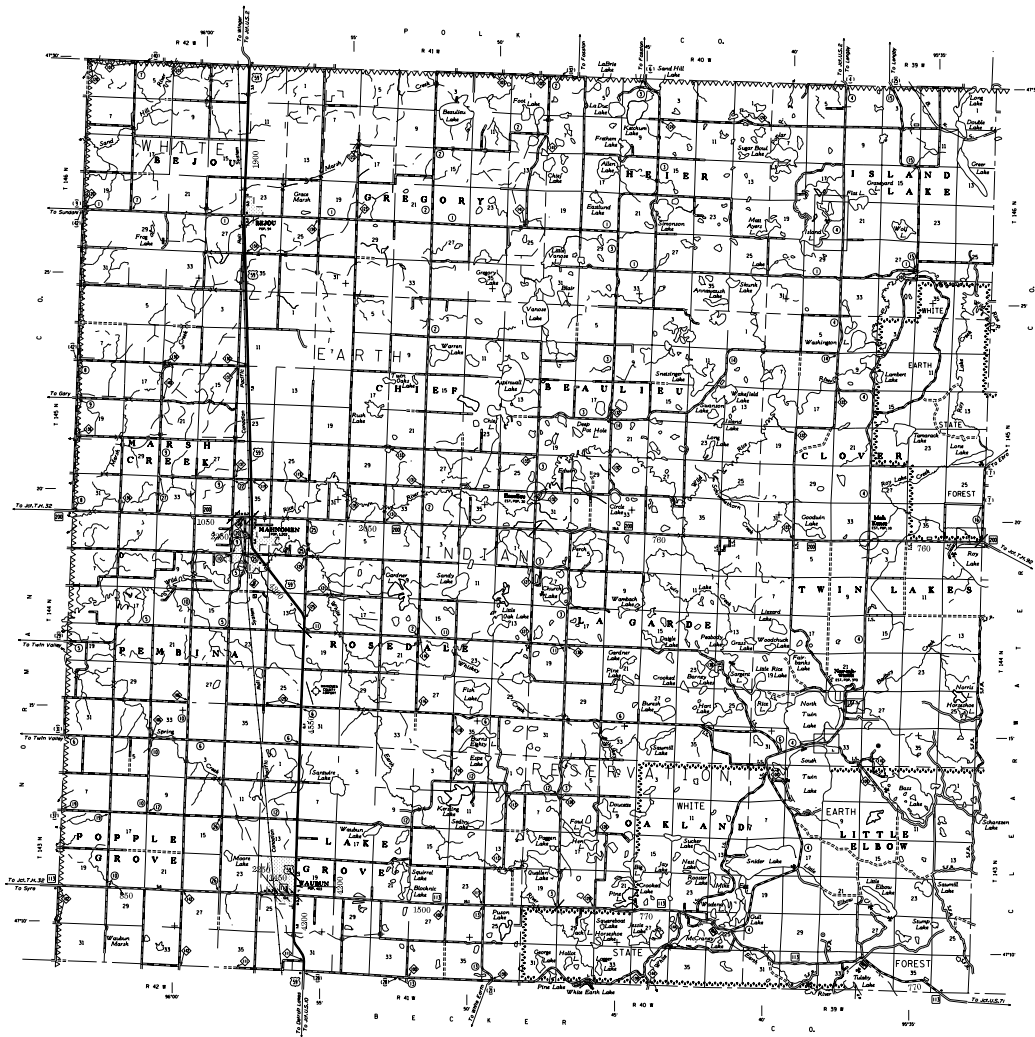

Overpass	Circle with 'O' inside
Underpass	Circle with 'U' inside
Roundabout	Circle with 'R' inside
Other Roadway Features	Various symbols for bridges, culverts, etc.
Water Features	Blue lines and areas for lakes, rivers, streams
Topographic Features	Contour lines, spot elevations
Settlements	Shaded areas for cities, towns, villages
Other Land Use	Various patterns for forests, parks, etc.
