His duties included coordinating installation of AVL equipment, training on the use of AVL, AVL reporting, MDSS Graphical User Interface, and promoting MDSS/AVL technology in District 6, District 7, and Metro area. Joe's current position with MnDOT is Transportation Team Leader in the Road Weather Technology Group that manages MDSS/AVL/RWIS/Salt Solutions Programs.
