## PARTNERSHIP INCENTIVES:

- 🚩 Receive written recognition by AGC and MNOSHA (all levels)
- 🚩 No penalty for non-serious violations (all levels)
- 🚩 Increased communication with MNOSHA through partnering (all levels)
- 🚩 Receive maximum good faith penalty reductions (levels 2 and 3)
- 🚩 Possible consideration as "best value" contractor (levels 2 and 3)
- 🚩 After one year at Level 2, qualify for MNOSHA CCP program (levels 2 and 3)
- 🚩 On-site compliance assistance provided by MINOSHA compliance (level 3)
- 🚩 No citations for hazards abated immediately during CCP site surveys (level 3)

### THREE AWARD LEVELS

**Level 1** - the basic level for applications wanting to meet the basic minimum requirements of a safety and health program

**Level 2** - the intermediate level focuses on employee involvement and supervisory training, for applicants desiring recognition for a more comprehensive safety and health program

**Level 3** - the peak level, now awarded on a site-specific basis, for applicants striving to be an industry leader with a very comprehensive safety and health program
